As I mentioned on the day, celebrating diversity is at the heart of Harmony Day but as I looked around the similarities between people smiling, enjoying companionship and caring for their families, I was reminded of the human experience that is common to us all.

Over the remainder of the term, Weld Square staff will participate in professional learning about Protective Behaviours. This is part of the curriculum and is a personal safety program designed to equip children with the knowledge and skills to act in ways to reduce the likelihood of abuse occurring and to help them to seek help if abuse occurs. Schools play an important role in supporting the development of student skills, knowledge and understanding to build their resilience and wellbeing. The two main themes of the program are - "We all have the right to feel safe at all times." and "We can talk with someone about anything no matter what it is." We will provide further information in future newsletters however please see you child's teacher or myself if you have any questions in the meantime.
